GENERAL INFORMATION

This low nitrogen formulation is designed to help lawns store energy and build roots so they can survive winter stress and rebound more quickly in the spring. Winterizer is specially formulated to fight winter fungal diseases. It is also for soils with low levels of phosphate as well as light sandy soil areas. Winterizer contains 1% iron and some added copper.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Home and Commercial Properties:

For best results apply 6 lb per 1,000 sq ft or 260 lb per acre of Winterizer just after Labor Day. This will give the lawn time to take in the nutrients and build a larger root system.

General Campus and Athletic Turf:

For best results apply 7 lb per 1,000 sq ft or 300 lb per acre to the general areas before school starts in the fall. Athletic fields used in the fall should be treated after the last game with 6 lb per 1,000 sq ft or 260 lb per acre.
