30% Sweet Tart Festulolium 30% Medium Red Clover 20% Alfalfa 10% White Ladino Clover 10% Alsike Clover

Alfalfa is often referred to as the "Queen of Forages," because it produces high yields that are highly digestible and high in protein. Alfalfa is important to deer for its calcium, protein, and vitamins to improve weight gain and antler development.

### White Ladino Clover

White Ladino Clover is the most palatable forage clover because when it goes to flower the deer will continue to eat it while rejecting other legumes. White Ladino Clover is an excellent source of calcium, protein, and energy required by white-tail deer.

### Alsike Clover

Alsike Clover is an easy to establish clover for poor quality soils. However, alsike clover is intolerant of drought and high temperatures. It provides a good source of energy, protein, and calcium required by deer.

# Planting & Seeding

This mixture is best planted in the spring when moisture is adequate. Recommended seeding rate is 20-25lbs per acre in a well-prepared seed bed. This will reduce competition and extend length of performance.

### **Fertilization**

Recommendation: Apply 300lbs high calcium lime and 200lbs GreenGuard 7-8-7 Vegetable & Flower before seeding and annually every fall. This will extend the life of the stand, attract more animals, and improve forage quality.

Maintenance: To attract deer all season long, mow three times during the summer. For improved fall performance cut plot sometime in early August and fertilize.
