Directions For Use:

Apply Hawk-I with ground equipment using sufficient volume of water to provide thorough spray coverage: 1 to 10 gallons per 1,000 square feet, depending on pest and usage rate. Do not apply through irrigation equipment. Use higher recommended rates under severe insect pressure. Always calibrate sprayers prior to use. Do not apply more than 0.4 lbs. active ingredient per acre per year. Do not apply Hawk-I to sod farms or nursery and ornamental crops grown for resale. Hawk-I is not for use on sod farms in Arizona.
