Directions For Use:

Apply T-Bird with ground equipment using 3–5 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. to provide thorough coverage. Use the higher recommended rates under severe disease pressure. Always calibrate sprayers prior to use. Continuous agitation is recommended to keep the product in suspension. When treating golf greens, always treat aprons and approaches to reduce any chance of carrying the disease onto the green.

Do not mix with products containing copper or highly alkaline pesticides as alkaline hydrolysis may reduce activity.
